A seamless palate of sophistication and poise, red fruit driven with generous flavours and texture. Secondary flavours of field mushroom and brioche build on the complexity and persistence.*

*A predominantly chardonnay sparkling which has spent nine years in tirage, shows lifted aromas reminiscent of fresh brioche, white flowers, oyster shell and exotic spice. A seamless and elegantly structured palate presence exhibiting characters of toasted sourdough, field mushroom, lemon curd and malted barley. The wine shows great tension and poise with the low dosage in perfect balance with fine tannins and natural acidity.*

*From the Don Valley in Tasmania's Northwest Barringwood produces this Schonburger, a smaller known German varietal. Made by renowned Tasmanian winemaker Jeremy Dineen, this wine shows a delicate palate of lychee and pear with a hint of spice, balanced with a crisp clean finish.*

2022 Small Wonder, Chardonnay Tamar valley, Tasmania 20



*Lively with citrus infused fruit. Layers of discrete flavours, gentle cool-climate feel, a suggestion of minerality – quite polite, but still offering concentrated, dense flavours. 10 months in barrel with 20% new oak*

2021 Bay of Fires Chardonnay Multi-regional, Tasmania 25



*Enjoy this Chardonnay of intense flavour and purity by starting with its aromas of white peach and lemon curd. Then take in the juicy but refined palate and its backbone of natural acidity and flavours centered around stonefruit, grapefruit and a touch of lemongrass. It's all rounded out with a malolactic creamy softness and a judicious French oak influence.*

An excellent example of cool climate Tassie Shiraz.*

2014 Moorilla 'White Cloth' Tamar Valley, Tasmania 150



*Slight pick tinge. High with Turkish delight and apple blossom aroma and indeed flavour. Stone fruits, spices aplenty, texture and rich-ish flavour. Lovely through the finish with a high acidity that sits comfortably in the wine. This is a blend of Chardonnay, Gewurztraminer, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris and Pinot Noir.*

2017 Moorilla 'Red Cloth' Tamar Valley, Tasmania 170



*Each variety (pinot noir, shiraz, cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, a tiny bit of riesling) was fermented individually in oak before blending to build a deep, complex wine that's still decidedly medium-bodied. Fruit intensity on the nose is excellent, backed by spicier, sweet notes of tobacco, leather and pepper. A soft but consistent acidity anchors a sophisticated, rewarding palate of red fruit, plums and a sweet, surprising vibrance.*
