MV Clover Hill 'Exceptionnelle' Pipers Brook, Tasmania 25



This Multi Vintage Exceptionnelle exhibits a light straw/green hue in the glass, with a fine persistent mousse. On the nose it delivers vibrant citrus and stone fruits which are complemented by layers of creamy complexity. The palate offers a crisp acidity and a concentration of rich and balanced lemon curd and lime which draw the wine through to a delicious and extended finish.

2009 House of Arras Grand Vintage Pipers Brook, Tasmania 35



A predominantly chardonnay sparkling which has spent nine years in tirage, shows lifted aromas reminiscent of fresh brioche, white flowers, oyster shell and exotic spice. A seamless and elegantly structured palate presence exhibiting characters of toasted sourdough, field mushroom, lemon curd and malted barley. The wine shows great tension and poise with the low dosage in perfect balance with fine tannins and natural acidity.

2020 Barringwood, Schonburger North Coast, Tasmania 17.5



From the Don Valley in Tasmania's Northwest Barringwood produces this Schonburger, a smaller known German varietal. Made by renowned Tasmanian winemaker Jeremy Dineen, this wine shows a delicate palate of lychee and pear with a hint of spice, balanced with a crisp clean finish.

2022 Small Wonder, Chardonnay Tamar valley, Tasmania 20



Lively with citrus infused fruit. Layers of discrete flavours, gentle cool-climate feel, a suggestion of minerality – quite polite, but still offering concentrated, dense flavours. 10 months in barrel with 20% new oak

2022 Bubb + Pooley, Chardonnay Coal River Valley, Tasmania 28



Fermented in concrete sphere (50 %) and a mixture of barriques and one puncheon (25 % new oak in total). Approximately 20 % of the wine proceeded through malolactic conversion. Stylistically Justin and Anna see this vintage as more in tune with their goals of freshness and higher acidity. It's racy and lean, with that concrete absolutely highlighting a core of chalky minerality. It also has a bright and lifted fragrance of honeysuckle, grapefruit, rolled oats and crushed almonds. Oak is absolutely not in the driver's seat here. Bottled unfiltered, so vegan friendly.

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It's a complex offering with sweet herbs notes floating over game, earth, mint, orange peel and sweet-sour cherry flavours. It smells a bit ripe and raspberried but then the palate takes all manner of complex turns. There's a laciness to the tannin, and a mineral-like aspect, with bunchy-herb notes ever-present and the general impression that everything has been carefully placed.

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Petit 'a' was created from a wish to make a more flexible, more approachable wine while still staying true to the Domaine A estate philosophy. The 2016 vintage shows a big wine, perfect for pairing with cold weather and a hearty meal—the savoury, almost-smoky nose presents bresaola and leather, as well as more typical bramble and blackcurrant, as well as a delicate, cassis-y sweetness. Palate-acid is high, and flavour continues to develop into black cherry, cocoa and coconut.

The tannins are firm but fine, with a full weight and texture carrying milk chocolate, cacao nibs and cherry ripe fruit. Full, yet beautifully balanced with intense flavours, the wine carries through for an intensely long finish.
